**On-Line Entries Procedures**

Dear Coach or Team Entries Manager

For team entries, all athletes must be entered using Easy Sport On-Line Entries.

Single entries such as an individual wishing to enter herself/himself as an unattached runner or affiliated with a school or club do NOT use on-line entries but enter by contacting Dennis Barrett by email at [dennis.barrett@mcgill.ca](mailto:dennis.barrett@mcgill.ca)

For team entries (school or club having multiple athletes to be entered), you need to use Easy Sport On-Line Entries found on the below link

**Once in the Easy Sport site, follow these procedures:**

1. Click on COACH, Select the 2011 McGill Open from the menu of meets then complete the information as requested on the Registration Screen. After you have completed Registration, for any future visits to Easy Sport On-Line Entries, choose LOG IN and enter your email and password.
2. Check to see if your team (school or club) is on the list of teams allowed in this meet. If you are not on the list, contact Dennis Barrett [dennis.barrett@mcgill.ca](mailto:dennis.barrett@mcgill.ca) to request to be added.  
***NOTE WELL – you need to do this at least 5 days before the entry deadline or chances are you will not be allowed to enter into this meet***
3. Create your Team Roster by typing per athlete first name and last name (e.g. Luc Thibideau), and indicate sex (M or F) and for university athletes only, indicate Grade as per below:
  - A. CIS Teams choose R (true rookie), E1 (first year competing in university but not a rookie), E2, E3, E4, or E5 to indicate respectively 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, or 5<sup>th</sup> year of eligibility
  - B. USA Teams use FR, SO, JR, or SR
  - C. Colleges & CGEP leave Grade blank
4. After your team roster has been established, enter each athlete you want in this meet into the appropriate event
5. Once you have completed all your entries and you are sure you don't have more, select to FINALIZE your entries. Once you do this, you will automatically receive an email from Easy Sport On-Line Entries confirming your file has been received and providing you with a copy of your entries for final careful checking.

NOTE: once you finalize, you CANNOT go back in and make changes. You can leave the site without finalizing and come back in to finish as many times as you want, **but you MUST FINALIZE before the entry deadline, otherwise you will not be allowed into the meet.**
